## Recycling Tips

- Please make sure recycling is:
  - clean and empty
  - free of food scraps
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Do not place recyclables in a plastic bag
- If in doubt, throw it out



## **Plastics**



### Acceptable

- Food and beverage containers
  - Plastics #1,2,4,5,7
- rigid plastic containers (pots, buckets, tubs)

- •Plastic wrappers
- •Plastic bags
- •Solo Cups
- •Straws, utensils, lids



## **Metal Cans**



### Acceptable

- Steel and Tin food cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Loose metal lids and tabs

• Foil (clean)

- •Scrap metal
- •Electronic Waste (batteries, phones, computers etc.)



## Paper



### Acceptable

Newspapers, Magazines, Office Paper

#### Books

Cardboard & Paperboard

• Cartons (clean)

- Wax coated paper
- Frozen food boxes
