On behalf of Lehigh University Transportation and Parking Services, I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Lehigh. This is an exciting time for you and your family and we wish you all great success.

Since first-year students are not permitted to have cars during their first year at Lehigh (with the exception of those who commute daily from home), we wanted to share with you how Lehigh can ease your concerns with transportation. With Lehigh's bus/shuttle system, Enterprise CarShare service, Zimride, Zagster, and public transportation, traveling around Lehigh University and commuting home is quite convenient.

Lehigh has five unique bus/shuttle services:

- 1) **T.R.A.C.S.:** (Take a Ride Around Campus Safely): Operates from 10:00 p.m. – 2:00 a.m., Sunday – Wednesday, and 10:00 p.m. – 3:00 a.m., Thursday – Saturday. T.R.A.C.S. arrives every 15 minutes at various locations on campus and in the surrounding community during the academic year.
- 2) **Mountaintop Service:** Transports students and faculty/staff through the Asa Packer Campus and to the Mountaintop Campus. This service is available on Sundays.
- 3) **Saucon Village Service:** Shuttles those living in the Saucon Village residences to the Mountaintop and Asa Packer Campuses.
- 4) **Goodman Campus Service:** Transports students to the Goodman Campus for athletic events.
- 5) **Athletic Service:** Operates every afternoon, taking Lehigh University varsity athletes to and from the Goodman Campus for practices.

Schedules of all Lehigh University bus routes and departure times are available on our website, [financeadmin.lehigh.edu/transportation](http://financeadmin.lehigh.edu/transportation), and we provide real-time tracking of all buses at [bus.lehigh.edu](http://bus.lehigh.edu). Students can also track buses on their smartphones using the free LehighU Live app, and follow us on Twitter @LehighUtransit.

Public transportation schedules are available on the Lehigh and Northampton Transportation Authority website, [www.lantabus.com](http://www.lantabus.com). The Bethlehem bus terminal is three blocks north of campus, making it convenient to commute home during breaks.

We also provide the service of Enterprise CarShare, which offers cars on campus available to rent for hourly, daily, or weekly use – [www.entreprisecarshare.com/Lehigh](http://www.entreprisecarshare.com/Lehigh), Zimride, Lehigh's ride sharing network, open only to Lehigh students, staff, and faculty, allows students to find a one-time ride or daily commute - [www.zimride.com/Lehigh](http://www.zimride.com/Lehigh), and Lehigh's bike sharing program. [www.zagster.com/Lehigh](http://www.zagster.com/Lehigh).

Because Lehigh is located in a residential area and parking on campus is limited, following our parking policies is essential. Parking areas are specifically assigned to various groups and all cars must be registered with our office. Please be advised that those who violate the "first-year student restriction" are subject to additional penalties including, but not limited to, suspension of parking privileges for subsequent years. Parking Services appreciates your cooperation with our parking policies.

If you are expecting a visitor, please obtain a temporary permit from our office at 106 Johnson Hall, prior to your visitor's arrival. Temporary visitor permits are \$5 per day. Visitor permits for Friday after 4:00 pm, Saturday, and Sunday may be purchased online at [go.lehigh.edu/parking](http://go.lehigh.edu/parking) (with Lehigh username and password).
