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1. Our Mission

2. Our Market

The Bethlehem Farmers' Market is seasonal, taking place each Thursday, May through October. The 2017 market will be held:

Every Thursday May 4 – October 26, 2017 11 AM – 3 PM (Live music 12 – 2 PM) Farrington Square (Intersection of New and Morton Streets in Southside Bethlehem) We are a proud member of Buy Fresh Buy Local Greater Lehigh Valley. This means that our market is a producer-only market (vendors must make what they sell, locally sourced ingredients strongly encouraged) AND they must be local (from the Greater Lehigh Valley). We encourage our vendors to accept SNAP benefits and those who can, do!

Each year our 12+ vendors offer: Fresh, local produce (typically both organic and chemical-free), fresh non-GMO meats and eggs, fresh baked breads and pastries, vegan baked goods, peanut butter, cupcakes and desserts, lunch items, flowers, and more!

3. Why Sponsorship is Necessary

Short answer? Running a not-for-profit farmers' market is expensive! The Bethlehem Farmers' Market is currently able to operate as a community service because it operates through Lehigh University. This generous support enables us to NOT charge for vendor spots, to pay our musicians and our market manager, pay for the City fees associated with inviting two "food trucks" to park on the street in front of the market, and pay for a few marketing materials – as budget allows.

But there is SO MUCH MORE we can be doing with and for our Southside community! Even after 10 years in our location, many Southside residents are still unfamiliar with the market. With the help of sponsors like you, we can reach out to our community AND educate them on the benefits of farmers' markets – including where they can use SNAP benefits!

2017 Season Goals:

(1) To increase marketing and promotions to the Southside residents! By reaching out to our community and meeting with organizations such as the Hispanic Center of the Lehigh Valley, Via, WIC office, United Way, and more, we hope to spread knowledge of the market. We feel that there are still residents who are either not aware of us, or feel intimidated by the location and by farmers' markets in general – viewing them as elitist establishments. But as like most markets, our vendors who are able, accept SNAP and FMNP vouchers. We would like to increase vendor participation in these programs AND increase promotions to the public that these options are available! We hope to do this through marketing materials that focus on promoting the market itself, our SNAP vendors, AND create materials translated into Spanish and possibly other languages.

(2) To implement children's educational programming! We hope to implement children's programming and special events in the summer to educate children on fresh produce in a fun way through: demonstrations/vegetable and fruit samples/educational activities/a passport program where they visit and talk to each farmer and receive a prize or token for completion/etc. By educating children, we help improve the health of our community and increase foot traffic from parents – thereby helping our farmers and vendors succeed as well!

In short, your support will help us to continue (and improve!) our efforts to: stimulate the local economy, preserve farmland and rural livelihoods, increase access to fresh food, and support a healthy Southside community! In return – we can help grow your business!
